Casting Agreement:

I agree to play any role assigned to me without complaint. In doing so, I also agree to wear the costumes, wigs, or hairstyles of the directors choosing without complaint (Please electronically sign this agreement by typing your name) (By typing your name you sign and agree to these terms)

Attendance Agreement:

By accepting a role, I agree to attend all mandatory rehearsals and performances of the production as defined by Mr. Hanaway and the rehearsal schedule. I understand that by missing more than 3 unexcused rehearsals, I forfeit my chance to be involved and consequently lose my role. I understand as well, that if I am going to miss rehearsal, that I must email Mr. Hanway that I am not going to be at that rehearsal. If he is not informed by email, it will count as an unexcused absence. No other method of informing of a missed rehearsal will be accepted. I also understand and agree to be at the entire rehearsal unless otherwise cleared by the director. I understand that by being habitually late and/or leaving early, I may consequently lose my role. I also understand that tech week is mandatory and will make all necessary schedule changes needed to attend rehearsal. I understand that by missing even one day of tech, I may forfeit my chance to be in a performance and/or all shows. I also agree to abide by all theatre rules while at rehearsals and performances, and treat every member involved with the production with respect and kindness. I understand by not following these rules at any time, Mr. Hanaway reserves the right to remove me from the show. (Please fill in your name)

Academic Agreement

By signing below, I, the student, understand that my academics are important and that I will focus on keeping my grades up while participating in the production. I understand that the following will become regular procedure with BTC in regards to academics. 1. Mr. Hanaway will be doing weekly grade checks. 2. If you have a C or below you will be flagged by Mr. Hanaway and watched more closely to ensure the grade does not fall, you will be notified of this. 3. If you have a D or below in a class you are required by Mr. Hanaway to attend study tables after school with that teacher to get assistance and raise your grade. We do not start rehearsal until 3:15, so you have a half an hour to get help. 4. If your grade reaches an F, you will be monitored and if no progress is seen in 2 weeks, you will be removed from your role.
