What's Expected of You

- 1. Rehearsals will start promptly at the specified time on the rehearsal schedule unless otherwise approved by Mr. Hanaway; you are expected to be on time. The quicker we start, the quicker we will be able to get out of rehearsal.**
- 2. Come prepared to rehearsals. You all have been given the rehearsal schedule and you know what rehearsal it is, always bring your script and a pencil.**
- 3. The rehearsal Schedule has been given to you, if you have listed conflicts on your audition form, these are excused, though you need to remind Mr. Hanaway any time you may miss. All other conflicts must be cleared by Mr. Hanaway, and you must email him your conflict/reason for missing and that you are going to miss before you do. the email to send it to is jhanaway@union.k12.in.us. Please note on the audition form you signed that more than 3 unexcused rehearsals, and you will be removed from the show. This also includes excessive tardiness/leaving early to rehearsals. PLEASE BE AWARE THAT LEAVING EARLY IS NOT ACCEPTABLE, and you are responsible for this.**
- 4. TECH WEEK rehearsals are mandatory, no excuses. If you have to miss a tech rehearsal; please understand that you may be removed from your role, or have to miss a performance due to this absence. In the event we cannot have a live performance; Recording rehearsals are 100% Mandatory, this is our "performance" and we have to have every single person there, no excuses. If you have to miss a day of recording please understand that you**

may be removed from your role, or have to miss a performance due to this absence.

5. I am kindly asking that you not cut or color your hair without our permission. The reason that we ask this is, there is a certain image we have in my mind for these characters. If we cast you and you're a brunette, then next week you are blonde, that is an issue, also boys, if we need you to have a part in your hair and your hair was long enough then, and you buzz your hair, that also creates an image problem.
